The academic deans recently met with the faculty separate academic assessment committee to discuss the program student learning outcomes and the impact of the Expedited Program Review process.

After considering the outcomes of that meeting, the Assessment Panel and the Academic Assessment Committee have agreed on the following:

Deans

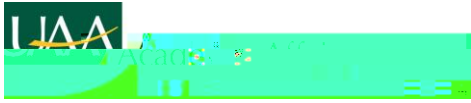
Typically, the deans review each program's Annual Assessment Report and provide feedback and provide feedback to the faculty. The Assessment Panel will review the reports, and deans will provide feedback on the reports. The Assessment Panel will incorporate into the Expedited Program Review process the feedback on the reports.

AY20 Annual Assessment Survey and Annual Academic Assessment

While programs should continue to complete their annual assessment reports, the requirements will be adjusted for AY20. Programs will be required to fill out the Annual Academic Assessment Survey. The survey will be available late in the year. Programs will be able to complete it prior to faculty going on contract in May. The report will stand in lieu of the annual assessment report for AY20.
