

<u>Department of Commerceicense Exceptions</u> For Travebutsidethe United States

Traveling outside the United Statescan present export control issues for followers ty of Alaska Anchora (de AA) employees. The export of tangible items (such as blueprints and blueprints) and commercial software and encryption code commonly found on laptops, tablets and phones is subject to export control regulations. However, the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) provide two exceptions to license requirements whe the tangible export of items and software containing encryption code is necessary for travel or relocation
